FARMERS MARKET VOUCHERS

Spring is finally here and that can only mean one thing! The Farmers Market Program is back in Somerset County. The purpose of the Farmers Market Program is to provide resources in the form of fresh, nutritious, locally grown fruits, vegetables and herbs from farmers markets, roadside stands and community supported agriculture programs to low-income seniors. Low-income seniors who



are at least 60 years old (by December 31, 2023) may qualify for this benefit. The income guidelines for one person is \$26,973 and two people is \$36,482 Farmers Market checks are distributed through the Area Agency on Aging of Somerset County. A flyer will be provided to each voucher recipient listing the eligible items for purchase and program guidelines when they receive their checks. These checks are then redeemable for fresh fruit and vegetables grown in Pennsylvania. Each consumer receives (5) \$10.00 Farmers Market checks to redeem at qualified farmers' markets or roadside stands within Somerset County. This year we will be mailing checks to eligible recipients.
