

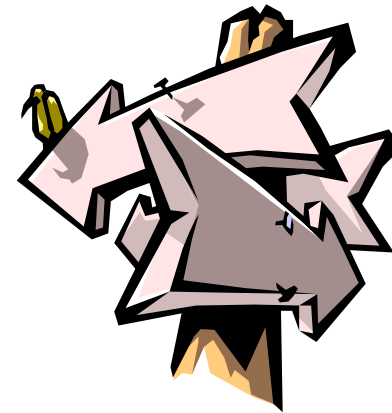

The Meyersdale Senior Community Center was established in 1971 and is located in the same building as the Adult Day Care.
