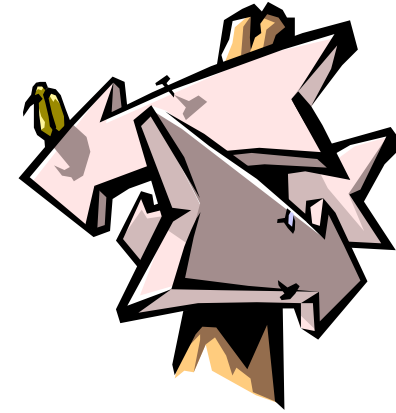

Currently the Somerset Senior Community Center, which is located in the County Seat, is the largest senior center in Somerset County.

Seniors travel from the surrounding towns of Berlin, Boswell, Garrett, Meyersdale and Rockwood.

The Somerset Senior Community Center is operated by the Area Agency on Aging of Somerset County and is managed by Senior Services Director Sandy Nicholson.

The center has kitchen facilities available for small scheduled functions and well maintained restrooms. The parking lot offers ample parking and is well lit for safety during the evening hours.
